<p>Achillea 'Firefly Sunshine' (Proven Winners)</p>		<p>Yarrow is one of the easiest perennials to grow and is a good choice for beginners. All it needs is full sun and well-drained soil. It thrives in average to poor soil and is drought tolerant once established. Plants grown in rich soil tend to be tall and floppy. After the flowers have faded, cut the plant back by half. This will likely stimulate a second flush of blooms in late summer.</p>
<p>Airplane Plant (also known as Spider Plant)</p>		<p>Spider Plant is one of the easiest houseplants to care for. Thrives best in low to minimal light and biweekly watering. Spider takes toxins and converts them to oxygen. It's an old standby but try dressing it up in an urn or letting it hang over a bookcase.</p>

Aloe		<p>Aloe vera is known as a succulent plant, which means it stores water in its leaves and stem. This makes it a hardy plant that needs very little water, allowing it to survive in dry environments. Aloe vera has a very short stem with thick, fleshy, greenish leaves fanning out from it. These leaves are where you find the goodness in Aloe vera.</p>
Christmas Cactus		<p>A Christmas Cactus is a tropical plant that does not naturally exist in nature. It was bred from two unique parent plants that both grow in the South American rainforests, specifically in Brazil. The plant is recognizable by its segmented stem and the brightly colored blooms that appear at the ends of them. Blooms are typically red, pink, purple, yellow, or white, and the blooms can occur at different times throughout the year. Most notably, they can appear near Christmas, which is where the name is derived.</p>

<p>Common Bearded Iris</p>		<p>Celebrate spring with the beautiful blooms of bearded iris. These perennial favorites start flowering in mid-spring and last until mid-June, depending on the variety. Bearded iris (<i>Iris germanica</i>) are a traditional garden flower for decorating graves on Memorial Day. In the temperate zones of the Midwest and Northeast, these bloomers are usually staging a spectacular show about that time.</p>
<p>Daylily 'Going Bananas' (Proven Winners)</p>		<p>One of the very best reblooming daylilies. Lightly fragrant, lemon yellow flowers open fully just above the relatively short clump of attractive green foliage. Blooms early in the daylily season and continues through the heat of summer into fall. Use in mass plantings or anywhere low maintenance perennials are needed.</p>
<p>Daylily 'Tiger Swirl' (Proven Winners)</p>		<p>Generally growing to a height of 32" with a spread of 18"-24", the Rainbow Rhythm Tiger Swirl Daylily is easily distinguishable by its bright yellow, gold, and orange shades, as well as its traditional green foliage. You can expect peak blooms in mid-summer months. These can be used as border plants, mass plantings, fillers in a container, and landscaping. They are also rabbit</p>

<p>Deep Purple Siberian Iris, possibly variety known as Caesar's Brother.</p>		<p>Showy, six-segmented flowers bloom in late spring; the 3 outer petals (falls) are beardless; the species flowers are shades of blue and purple; grass-like foliage. Grows in full sun or partial shade; tolerant of poor, dry soils, but grows best in fertile, moist, slightly acid soils.</p>
<p>Dogwood trees - pink and white varieties</p>		<p>This flowering tree is one of the most noble of flowering trees due to its timeless beauty. It is the perfect tree for landscaping as it can be appreciated during all four seasons. The tree's showy white or pink flowers are breathtaking in the spring. They typically flower between April and May, depending on the region. Deep green leaves turn a shade of red-purple in the fall. Glossy scarlet berries appear in the fall and winter, and they are relished by winter songbirds. This popular deciduous tree matures at 15 to 30 feet. It is a low branching tree that has about a 25 foot spread. It nicely branches out to be wider than it is tall when mature. It prefers partial shade to full sun and is adaptable to various soil types. This includes acidic, moist, or loamy soil and even clay. This very hardy tree is drought tolerant.</p>

<p>Hibiscus - unknown variety</p>		<p>Perennial hibiscus have big, disc-shaped, hollyhock-like flowers that can be 6 to 12 inches across. The perennial hibiscus species found in gardens are the result of hybridizing native hibiscus species.</p>
<p>Hippo Rose' Hypoestes (Proven Winners)</p>		<p>Here's a robust foliage plant that will grow in sun or shade, and will also do well when you bring it inside for the winter! Hippo Rose is a robust version of yesterday's polka dot plant...and is easy to grow, and easy to enjoy with strong color, even without a bloom!</p>
<p>Ice plant</p>		<p>The name "ice plant" derives from tiny hairs on the plant that reflect light in a manner that resembles ice crystals. The foliage is fleshy and succulent-like and morphs into a darker color as fall temperatures drop. In the southern part of its range, it may be evergreen.</p> <p>Individual plants often spread as much as 24 inches, although some instances of 3 or even 4 feet across are reported. It is used</p>

		<p>most often in sunny but sheltered desert gardens, rock gardens, or slopes or as a ground cover or edging plant. This plant can be invasive in some areas, so caution should be used when planting it.</p>
<p>Liatris 'Kobold Original'</p>		<p>A native American wildflower excellent for border, meadow, or wild garden settings. Spikes of rounded, fluffy, pink-purple flower heads from summer into fall top strong, erect, leafy foliage. Liatris flowers on multiple spikes that are seldom taller than 2 1/2'. One of the finest selections.</p>
<p>Mandevilla - white blooms with a blush of pink on the fringes. (see photo)</p>		<p>The mandevilla plant is a beautiful patio plant for our area. It adds a touch of a tropical atmosphere to any location. This variety has white blooms with a blush of pink on the fringes. You can plant it or keep it potted and bring it inside during the winter to have it year after year!</p>

<p>Nepeta 'Cat's Pajamas' (Proven Winners)</p>		<p>An improved Catmint, the petite and sweet Nepeta Cat's Pajamas dashes skyward to flaunt countless lavender flowers from soil line to tips. Aptly named, the 1920's saying 'the cat's pajamas' is defined as an excellent person or thing. Blooms 2-3 weeks earlier than classic varieties. Long blooming! As flowers begin to fade, the rosy purple calyxes remain to supply an additional splash of color. Seeds are sterile.</p> <p>They are ideal for rock gardens, containers and border fronts. Dependable, long-blooming, deer and rabbit resistant – absolutely trouble free. One of the best plants to edge or under plant a rose bed.</p>
<p>PawPaw Tree (Two trees are needed to bear fruit)</p>		<p>The pawpaw has great landscaping potential, eventually growing into 20- to 40-foot-high cone-shaped trees with thick, heavy leaves in the spring and a rich golden color in the fall. The caterpillars of zebra swallowtail butterflies feed exclusively on pawpaws, encouraging more colorful visitors to your garden. Even better, deer tend to stay away from pawpaw trees.</p> <p>Nutritionally speaking, the pawpaw fruit is a treasure trove. Vegans will be happy to learn that pawpaw contains numerous amino acids humans need. The pawpaw provides as much potassium as bananas, and three times the Vitamin C in apples. They contain plenty of other important nutrients, too, such as</p>

<p>Phlox s. 'Blue Emerald'</p>	 <p><small>Courtesy of Walter's Gardens, Inc.</small></p>	<p>Low, 4-inch-tall mats of evergreen, soft, needle-like foliage are smothered by fragrant, star-shaped blue blooms in early spring. This one is very popular for rock gardens and edging. This drought-tolerant creeper is best in smaller areas in full sun and well-drained soils. It is excellent for hillside erosion control.</p>
<p>Salvia 'Perfect Profusion' (Proven Winners)</p>		<p>This gorgeous variety reblooms multiple times and makes the perfect rounded plant! Beautiful icy blue flowers hold on to a long dark green stem and create a spike look. These low maintenance flowers are left alone by deer and rabbits so no need to worry about pets! A wonderful fragrance matches the beauty of this flower and should be a staple in every garden. Perfect Profusion is easy to grow and works wonders in a bed, border, as ground cover, or anywhere you want a burst of icy blue color in your landscape. You can also cut these flowers and add them to bouquets and vases for beautiful arrangements. It blooms best in full sun and will fill your spring and</p>

<p>Sedum 'Lemonjade' (Proven Winners)</p>		<p>Stonecrop) Sedum ROCK 'N GROW® 'Lemonjade' is a real head turner and brings a unique color into the sunny border or containers. The bright green foliage with citron yellow flower heads create a lot of interest in the late summer and will take on a pink flush as the cold weather approaches. It typically grows 16-18 inches tall.</p>
<p>Succulents</p>		<p>Succulents are drought resistant plants in which the leaves, stems, or roots have become more than usually fleshy by the development of water-storing tissue. They are favored as houseplants for their attractiveness and ease of care. If properly potted, succulents require little maintenance to survive indoors.</p>
<p>Wandering Jew (10" hanging basket)</p>		<p>Wandering Jew Plant finds its way into hanging baskets and mixed annual containers for the summer because of its easy-going, tolerant nature and the colorful leaves that hang down from hanging baskets.</p>

<p>Washington Hawtho6/rn tree</p>		<p>Grows to 25 feet. Small tree with pendulous branches, dark green, shiny leaves. Reddish-purple leaves emerge in spring, then turn dark green as they are joined by a graceful display of white flowers. In autumn, the leaves turn orange, scarlet or purple. Edible Red berries extend the colorful show into winter. The berries are also eaten by songbirds, such as Cedar Waxwings, also ruffed grouse, fox sparrow, wood duck, turkey, bobwhite and pheasant eat the fruit.</p>

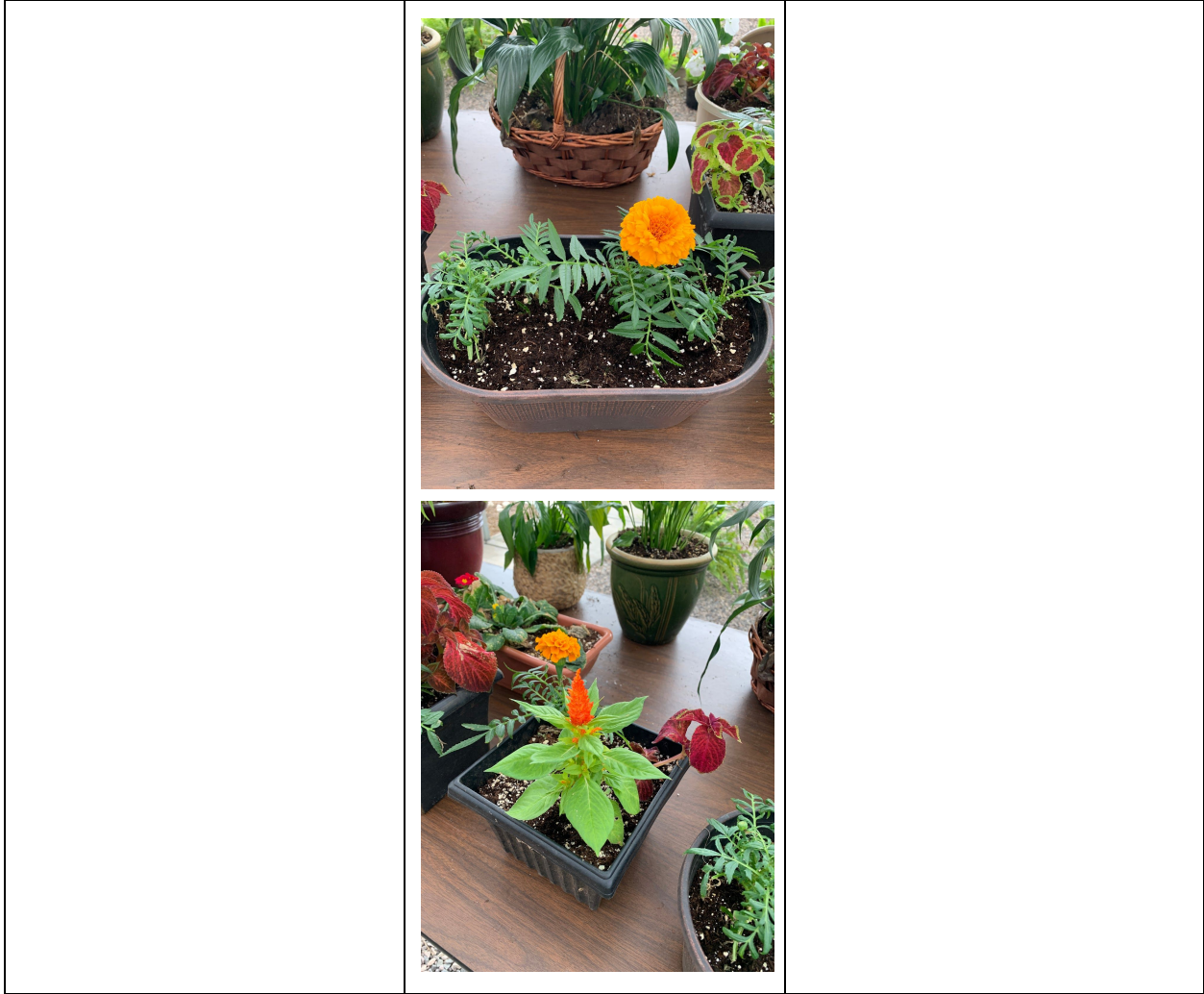
